SC-02 Splash Cowl Installation Instructions

Tool Required: 1/4" Nut Driver or Flat-Blade Screwdriver

1) For 1-inch shafts, stick the adhesive shim to the curved inside of the shaft bracket first. For 1-1/8" shafts, omit the shim.

2) Tilt the Cowl to one side and push it forward onto the shaft. CAUTION - this takes some force. Be sure the *upper* front half is *opposite* the bracket side as shown.

Tip: Heat Cowl in hot water for easier installation (makes the plastic softer).



- 3) After installation, the front of the Cowl can be straightened by bending if needed.
- 4) Install the band clamp just tight enough so the Cowl position can be adjusted by hand.
- 5) Position the Cowl 2-3 inches below the gunwale of the boat. Adjust as needed for the least splash while cruising. Tighten the clamp at the best position.
- 6) Optional: Fill the cut in the front of the Cowl with epoxy putty. Use tape underneath to prevent it from running. Sand or trim when cured.
